- **ü** To design the assessment methodology of the single-parent families' quality of life (quantitative and quantitative dimensions)
- ü To assess the single-parent families' quality of life from Romania, based on the constructed methodology
- **Ü** A set of measures in order to fundament the policies regarding single-parent families' protection
- **ü** To disseminate the project results and to demonstrate the utility of the assessment methodology of single-parent families' quality of life.



General Objective: to elaborate a methodology in order to evaluate the specific and the global impact (on short and on long time) of the present family policies' objectives on the behaviour and on the evolution of the families' structures, both at regional and at national level.

Results:

- Conceptual delimitations regarding the family policy notion. Comparative analysis of the family policies developed member states of the UE;
- ü To elaborate the documentation in order to underlie the evaluation methodology of the family policies impact upon the behaviour and upon the evolution of the families' structures in Romania;
- To construct the necessary instruments in order to elaborate the evaluation methodology, in accordance with the objectives and with the programs of the family policies from Romania (to elaborate the impact evaluation methodology regarding family policies: quantitative evaluation methodology of the family policy efficacy; evaluation methodology in order to evaluate the economic situation of the families with children; econometric models in order to realize an analytical evaluation of the family policies impact);
- ü To evaluate family policies from Romania basing on the constructed methodology (to apply the methodology);
- U To analyze the results obtained by applying the evaluation methodology regarding the impact of the family policies upon the behaviour and upon the evolution of the family structures in Romania;
- ü To disseminate the results and to demonstrate the utility of the evaluation methodology.

Results:

Survey based on questionnaires and interview guides (applied on managers, co-financers and beneficiaries) regarding 24 social services PHARE projects developed in 16 counties from Romania (day care centres for elderly, domicile services for elderly, centres for homeless persons, family I support centres and child protection centres, residencies for children living the child care institutions, protected residencies for disabled persons, social canteens, etc.)
